





All San Ysidro School District schools have systems and procedures in place to enforce the District's bullying prevention policies. All alleged claims of bullying are investigated and reported to District personnel. Documentation for various reporting and accountability data is collected. Each campus uses the district-provided investigation form and keeps all reports on file at the site level for three years.

The following anti-bullying resources/strategies are utilized to support students and to prevent bullying:

- Social/ Emotional Curriculum-Second Step
- Restorative Practices
- PBIS Lessons throughout the school year
- Social skills groups
- Anti-bullying class/school presentations
