- Our Promotion Ceremony will be held on June 10, 2021 at 9:00 am at San Ysidro High School's Football Stadium.
- If you are unable to attend the In-Person Ceremony a mini drive-thru promotion will be held on Friday, June 11th from 8:30 am to 9:00 am.

## **COVID-19 IN PERSON PROMOTION PROTOCOLS:**

• All promoting students and adult guests must sign the SUHSD Graduation/Promotion waiver prior to entering the promotion venue. Please bring the waiver(s) with you to the ceremony. They are available on our school website. Minors attending as guests may have a parent/guardian add their names to the

waiver and sign for them.

- All students, guests and staff must have a temperature check prior to entering the venue. Allow enough time for your family to park and be screened.
- All students and guests must wear a mask (covering both the mouth and nose) at all times— before, during and after the event.
- Prior to entry into the ceremony, the student and (no more than four from the same household) guests must wait together, maintaining at least six feet of distance from other groups.
- Once in the venue, students will be directed to the basketball courts (six feet apart) while guests will be seated in the stands. Guests of the promoting student will be expected to sit together, maintaining six feet of distance from other groups while seated in the stands.
- Restrooms will be available for use by parents, guests and staff.
- Promotion is expected to last 30-45 minutes.
- Immediately following the ceremony, guests will need to vacate the stands.
- There will be a professional photographer to photograph each student as they are on stage. Information will be provided the day of Promotion.

# **IN-PERSON PROMOTION DRESS GUIDELINES:**

- Students should wear clothing they would wear for a dinner or a nice function with their parents. Undergarments should not show at any time. Modest dresses, slacks, and collared shirts are appropriate. Jeans are not allowed!
- Students should not carry cell phones into the ceremony. Please hold your child's phone for them.
- Students should not bring a camera, purse, or any items that you will have to be handheld.
- Students should not wear pointed heels on the field as they may make walking difficult. Wedge shoes or flat shoes are permissible.
- Students should wear sunscreen as it may be hot and sunny.

## EVENT RULES:

- All students, guests, and staff must wear a mask (covering both the mouth and nose), at all times before, during and after the event.
- Each promoting student is allowed to have FOUR (4) guests.
- Guests of the promoting student will be expected to sit together and may **NOT** be transferred to another student due to limited space for each family.
- Minors are included in the total guest count maximum of 4.
- Guests MUST arrive with the promoting student in order to be admitted into the venue.
- Promotion is expected to last 30-45 minutes.
- No outside food/drink or concessions are permitted within the venues.
- At the conclusion of the ceremony, please help prevent traffic jams by exiting the facility and parking lot in a timely manner.
