Continuing students should have a Chromebook already check out to them.


New students will be able to check out a Chromebook at the school library.

1. Enter your student's District Google username
 - Example: StudentID@sysdschools.org (123456@sysdschools.org)
2. Enter your student's District Google password
 - Example: syBirthDate (sy03/06/2003)
3. Click Next to log in

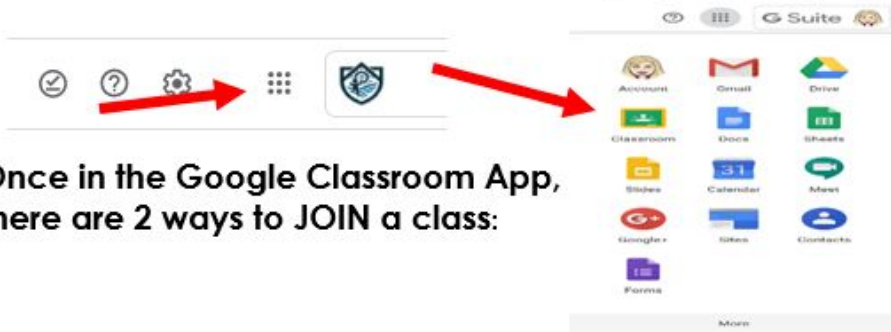

Get on the Internet using the Google Chrome Browser, 

Click on the Waffle and select the Google Classroom App.



Once in the Google Classroom App, there are 2 ways to JOIN a class:

Joining a Google Classroom

1. Click on the + sign in the right-hand corner, then select Join Class, and a window will pop-up asking you for a class code:



Enter the class code that was provided by your teacher or the school, then click JOIN and you will be added to the class.

OR

2. If your teacher has already sent you an invitation to join a class you will see a class in your Google Classroom App.



You need to click JOIN and you will be added to the class.

Attendance: DAILY attendance is essential to academic success.

Perfect Attendance

- Students must be on time and attend every day
- Awards given monthly and/or at the end of each grading period

Reporting an Absence

- Call the school site office

Chronic Absenteeism

- Students who are absent more 10% of the instructional days
- Attendance Program to support students who are chronically absent
 - Phone calls & Home visits
 - Saturday School (starting late fall to early winter)



Independent Study Contract

- Planned Absences for 5 or more days
- Contract will include completion of work provided and must be approved by school principal.
- Upon return to school with completed work, students will be marked present for the days of the contract.
