# SAN YSIDRO SCHOOL DISTRICT APPLICATION FOR INDEPENDENT CITIZENS' OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

The Board of Education of the San Ysidro School District is seeking qualified, interested individuals to serve on a committee of community leaders which will serve as the Independent Citizens' Oversight Committee ("COC") for the school facilities bond program.

#### **Establishment of a Citizens' Oversight Committee**

After a bond authorized under Proposition 39 is passed, state law requires that the San Ysidro School District Board appoint an Independent Citizens' Oversight Committee to work with the District.

### **Committee Responsibilities**

In accordance with Education Code Section 15278(b), the Citizens' Oversight Committee shall:

- Review expenditure reports produced by the District to ensure that bond proceeds were expended only for the purposes set forth in Measure/Funding Application and
- Present to the Board in public session, an annual written report outlining their activities and conclusions regarding the expenditure from bondproceeds.

The Bylaws which govern the Citizens' Oversight Committee are attached to this Application.

#### **Appointment of Committee Members**

All appointments will be made by the Board from applications submitted to the District.

The Committee shall consist of at least seven (7) members appointed by the Board from a list of candidates submitting written applications, and based on criteria established by Prop 39, to wit:

- One (1) member shall be the parent or guardian of a child enrolled in the District.
- One (1) member shall be both a parent or guardian of a child enrolled in the District and active in a parent-teacher organization, such as the P.T.A. or a school site council.
- One (1) member active in a business organization representing the business community located in the District.
- One (1) member active in a senior citizens' organization.
- One (1) member active in a bona-fide taxpayers' association.
- Two (2) members of the community at-large.

## **Time Commitment and Term**

Initial appointments will be staggered, such that some of the initial appointees will be appointed to serve one full two-year term. The other initial appointments will serve a one-year term, but will be eligible for reappointment by the Board for a second and third two-year term.
