Surprise Chromebook Giveaway for 100 sixth graders at Smythe Elementary School in San Ysidro!

Cox Communications employees to lead computer build workshop, surprise students at Smythe Elementary with their own laptop

WHO: Cox Communications employees will help 20 Smythe Elementary students in the San Ysidro School District each build a Kano computer. The 20 computers will then be donated by Cox to the school during a special ceremony where the 20 students, in addition to 80 sixth graders, will be surprised with their own Chromebook laptop to take home – just in time for the holidays. Students were selected by the school based on need.

Cox Communications is holding the workshop in partnership with EveryoneOn, a national non-profit organization working to eliminate the digital divide through partnerships with the technology industry, content creators, libraries and other organizations.

WHAT: The Kano Creative Computing computer kits are designed to get students to build a computer and get started coding with little guidance.
