

MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. HOLIDAY: MON, JAN 18TH

On Monday, January 18th our schools and district office were closed out of respect for the Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday.



SCHOOLS CONTINUE TO PROVIDE DISTANCE LEARNING ACADEMY FOR ALL STUDENTS IN JANUARY

As we move into the last two weeks of January the county of San Diego continues to remain in the Purple Tier. On January 14th, the state released new guidelines for reopening schools which indicates schools may reopen when their county's COVID case rate drops below 25 per 100,000. As of January 19th, San Diego county reported an adjusted case rate per 100,000 over a 7 day period of 60.6 per 100,000, for the period of January 3rd through January 9th. These county COVID case rates indicate that at this time all of our schools will continue to provide Distance Learning Academy for all students at least until the end of January 2021.

Note, schools located within counties below a 25 per 100,000 case rate may reopen within the new state guidelines, if they have not already reopened beginning on February 15th. While in the new Deep Purple Tier, schools remain in distance learning and may also meet the needs of at risk students within the state's small cohort guidance.

The Governor's Safe Schools for All Plan (<u>Summary: California's Safe Schools for All</u> <u>Plan</u>) released in January 2021 requires districts to update their COVID Safety Plans to include four pillars: 1) Funding; 2) Safety & Mitigation; 3) Oversight & Assistance; and 4) Transparency & Accountability. The district's current COVID Safety Plan for schools already includes the vast majority of the latter categories, thus, we anticipate the update will be completed and brought to a special board meeting on Wednesday, January 27th.

Thankfully, the distribution of vaccinations have begun in San Diego with Tier IA: healthcare personnel and assisted living facilities. The healthcare professionals within our schools such as, our nurse, school health clerks, and speech pathologists are now eligible to make an appointment for the COVID vaccine. The great news is that during the last few weeks about three of our Tier 1A eligible employees received the vaccine. California has placed educators within the next stage of vaccine distribution: Tier 1B. Thus, all of our staff in schools and the district office will have access to the vaccine as soon as the county has completed offering vaccines to Tier 1A individuals.

Our district continues to partner with the county health department to offer free COVID testing to our employees. All employees returning to the work place after the winter break have been COVID testing to help ensure the safety of our schools and district office. Any individual countywide, including our staff and community may access the county's free COVID testing locations if they are experiencing COVID symptoms, if they have been exposed, or if they are an essential worker that requires COVID testing. 
During the weeks of January 18th and January 25th all school and district offices will be available to the public via telephone, Zoom virtual meetings and by appointments, as necessary.
