






#### SAN YSIDRO SCHOOL DISTRICT STUDENT LITERARY ANTHOLOGY

We proudly expect our school playgrounds construction completion to be during the month of March. At which point we plan to hold groundbreaking ceremonies for each school.










#### SUNSET ELEMENTARY SCHOOL VISIT
























































































































#### LA MIRADA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL VISIT
