"SAN DIEGO COUNTY SCHOOL TEST SCORES INCH UP LESS THAN ONE PERCENTAGE POINT" (Colom)

The San Diego Union Tribune published an article this week about the spring 2019 statewide assessments as they were released to the public on Thursday. The scores across San Diego County were flat overall. In our district we had a gain of 2% in Math and 1% in English Language Arts. It is important to point out that we have been improving steadily every year since our baseline year 2014-2015. San Ysidro's total gains since 2015 have been 7% in English Language Arts and 9% in Math!
