
SAFETY PATROL NIGHT AT PETCO PARK

SUPERINTENDENT POTTER LEADING STATE LEGISLATIVE ADVOCACY ON BEHALF OF EDUCATION

From Wednesday, October 11th through Friday October 13th, Superintendent Potter was serving as a state educational leader by chairing the ACSA Vice Presidents of Legislative Action team and serving as an ACSA State Executive Board Member for the Leadership Assembly. Dr. Potter currently serves on the state executive board of directors as the ACSA Vice-President for Legislative Action at the state level.

During the 2022-2023 legislative session, ACSA has a positive influence on the state budget and policy outcomes on behalf of students and school leaders with the help of unprecedented levels of member engagement. Some of ACSA's advocacy success from the past legislative year were:

- Robust and Stable School Funding (Full Funding of the Local Control Funding Formula, Saved \$2.4 Billion in Proposed Cuts and \$14 Billion School Facilities Bond)
- Staffing Shortage: Recruitment and Retention (60-day Substitute Extension and Hiring Retired Educators Flexibilities, Classified Position Hiring Restrictions and Transitional Kindergarten Staffing)
- Student Wellness and Mental Health (Mental Health Funding)
- The Fight for Students and Educators (Increased Transparency and School Stability and Preserving School Transportation Services)
