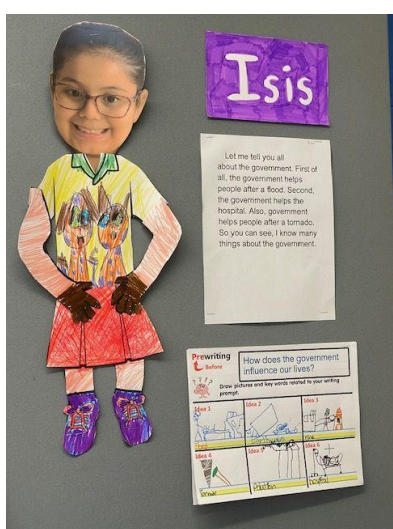
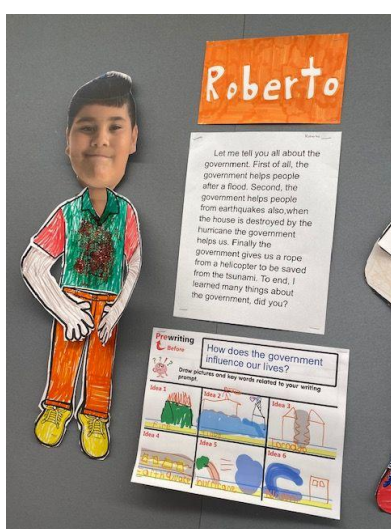
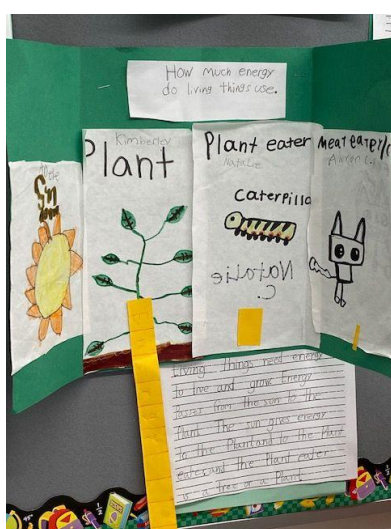
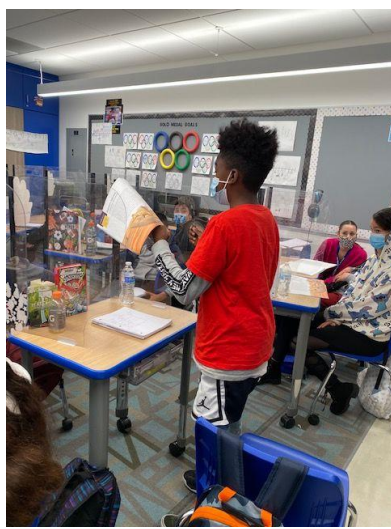


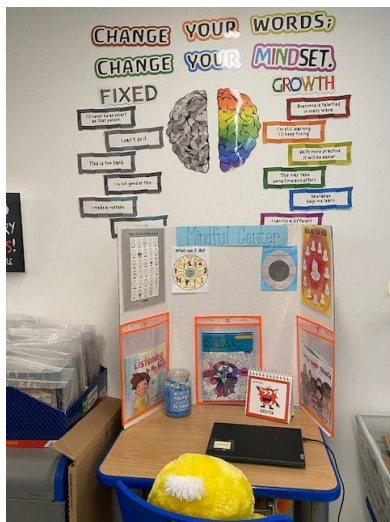
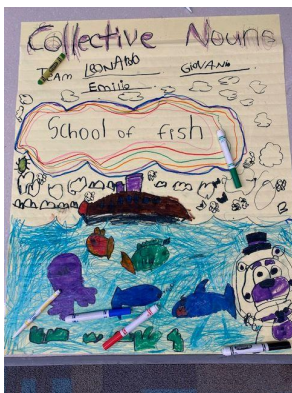
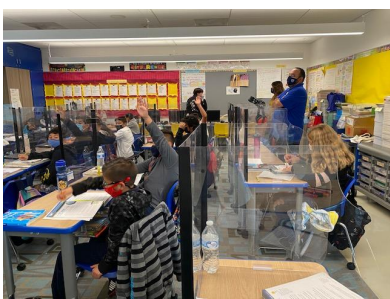


LA MIRADA SCHOOL VISIT

SAN YSIDRO SCHOOL DISTRICT COVID-19 DASHBOARD

This Dashboard is an effort for our district to be transparent regarding COVID cases. From July 26 through October 29, there have been a total of 100 cases of which 97 have been contact traced to outside community transmission, and not from within our schools. Thus, of our total student and staff population of just over 5,000, only 2%, have reported a positive COVID case.
