Dear SYSD Families & Colleagues,

With the recent news of the Governor's [Regional Stay at Home Order](#) due to a statewide COVID surge, along with escalating COVID transmission rates that our geographic region is currently experiencing, our district has decided for safety reasons to delay the launch of our Blended Learning Academy instructional program option until sometime between February and March 2021, pending San Diego county returning to the Red Tier and authorization by county and state health departments. This means that for the month of January 2021 all schools within our district will continue to provide a robust Distance Learning Academy wherein students will remain in their current class/es. Also, we are excited to share that our free **Virtual Tutoring Program** launched on December 9th and families can register their children for this program at this [link](#).

Our district is continuing to plan for the launch of the Blended Learning Program option. In order for the district to provide both a Distance Learning Academy and Blended Learning Program in the future, class changes may be required due to staffing limitations. The district is working collaboratively with our labor leaders to navigate the complexities of simultaneously staffing for our two main instructional programs. Our district's instructional program staffing plans are based upon input from the family surveys indicating whether they would like their child placed in either the Distance Learning Academy or Blended Learning Program; along with the needs of teachers. While our district will do its best to keep students with the same teacher, a number of students may experience a teacher change in the coming months as the district prepares for the implementation and staffing of our Phase III instructional program options: 1) Blended Learning Program; 2) Distance Learning Academy; and 3) Specialized Cohorts for At-Risk Students. New teacher assignments and student class changes that may be required for the implementation of Phase III will not occur until the launch of our Blended Learning Program in February or March 2021, if our county is returned to the Red Tier.

Please know our first priority is the safety of our students, families, staff and community, therefore, all school and district office staff members will work from home the week prior to winter break: Monday, December 14th through Friday, December 18th. School and district office staff may be reached next week via phone or email with this [directory](#) of contact information. Staff currently working at schools and at the district office will return to their work locations in January on the date identified within their [work calendars](#). While our district is taking this precautionary safety measure, it is important to note that to date, none of the SYSD positive COVID-19 cases have proven to be directly related to transmission within any of our schools or facilities. As you plan to celebrate the holidays, please remember to keep in mind the health regulations to keep your family safe.

Our free student meals program will continue on Wednesday, December 16th at La Mirada and Willow (11:30am-1pm), and San Ysidro Middle School (2:30pm-3:30pm). The weekly student meal program will be closed during winter break and will reopen on Wednesday, January 13, 2021.

All schools will be closed for winter break from Monday, December 21st through Wednesday, January 6th. Students' first day of school after winter break for our Distance Learning Academy is Thursday, January 7th.

We sincerely appreciate your continued patience and understanding as our district navigates this unprecedented and difficult time.

Estimadas Familias y Colegas de SYSD

Con la noticia reciente de la Orden Regional de Permanecer En Casa [Regional Stay at Home Order](#) del Gobernador debido a un aumento repentino de COVID en todo el estado, junto con las tasas de transmisión de COVID en aumento que nuestra región geográfica está experimentando actualmente, nuestro distrito ha decidido, por razones de seguridad, retrasar el lanzamiento de nuestra opción del Programa de Aprendizaje Combinado hasta febrero o marzo de 2021, si es que el condado de San Diego regresa al Nivel Rojo y los departamentos de salud estatales y del condado dan su autorización. Esto significa que todas las escuelas dentro de nuestro distrito continuarán brindando un sólido Aprendizaje Académico a Distancia para los estudiantes en enero de 2021 donde los estudiantes permanecerán en sus clases actuales. Nos complace compartirles que nuestro **Programa de Tutoría Virtual** gratuito fue lanzado el 9 de diciembre y que las familias podrán inscribir a sus hijos en este programa en el este [enlace](#).

Nuestro distrito continúa planeando el lanzamiento de la opción del Programa de Aprendizaje Combinado. Para que el distrito proporcione tanto el Programa de Aprendizaje Académico a Distancia como el Programa de Aprendizaje Combinado en el futuro, es posible que se requieran cambios en las clases debido a limitaciones de personal. El distrito está trabajando en colaboración con nuestros líderes laborales para navegar las complejidades de tener personal simultáneamente para nuestros dos programas principales de instrucción. Tome en cuenta que los planes de personal del programa de instrucción de nuestro distrito se basan en los comentarios de las encuestas familiares indicando si le gustaría que su hijo fuera colocado en el Programa Académico de Aprendizaje a Distancia o en el Programa de Aprendizaje Combinado; junto con las necesidades de los maestros. Si bien nuestro distrito hará todo lo posible para mantener a los estudiantes con el mismo maestro, varios estudiantes podrán experimentar un cambio de maestro en los próximos meses mientras el distrito se prepara para la implementación y el personal en la Fase III de nuestras opciones de programas de instrucción 1) Programa de Aprendizaje Combinado; 2) Programa Académico de Aprendizaje a Distancia; y 3) Personal Especializado para Estudiantes en Riesgo. Las nuevas asignaciones de maestros y los cambios de clases de los estudiantes que puedan ser necesarios para la implementación de la Fase III no ocurrirán hasta el lanzamiento de nuestro

Programa de Aprendizaje Combinado en febrero o marzo de 2021, si nuestro condado regresa al Nivel Rojo.

Por favor sepa que nuestra prioridad es la seguridad de nuestros estudiantes, familias, personal y comunidad, por lo tanto, todos los miembros del personal de las escuelas y la oficina del distrito trabajarán desde casa la semana anterior a las vacaciones de invierno: del lunes 14 al viernes 18 de diciembre. El personal tanto de la escuela como el de la oficina del distrito podrá ser contactado la próxima semana por teléfono o correo electrónico con este [directorio de contactos](#). El personal que actualmente trabaja en las escuelas y la oficina del distrito regresará a sus lugares de trabajo en enero en la fecha identificada en sus [calendarios labores](#). Si bien nuestro distrito está tomando esta medida de seguridad preventiva, es importante tener en cuenta que hasta la fecha, ninguno de nuestros casos positivos de COVID-19 en SYSD ha demostrado estar directamente relacionado con la transmisión dentro de las escuelas o instalaciones de SYSD. Cuando planea celebrar las fiestas, recuerde tener en cuenta las normas de salud para mantener a su familia segura.

Nuestro programa de comidas gratuitas para estudiantes continuará el miércoles 16 de diciembre en La Mirada y Willow (de 11:30 am a 1:00pm), y en San Ysidro Middle School (de 2:30 pm a 3:30pm). El programa semanal de comidas para estudiantes estará cerrado durante las vacaciones de invierno y volverá a abrir el miércoles 13 de enero, 2021.

Todas las escuelas estarán cerradas durante las vacaciones de invierno desde el lunes 21 de diciembre hasta el miércoles 6 de enero. El primer día de clases de los estudiantes después de las vacaciones de invierno para nuestro Programa Académico de Aprendizaje a Distancia será el jueves 7 de enero.

Agradecemos sinceramente su continua paciencia y comprensión mientras nuestro distrito atraviesa este momento difícil y sin precedentes.

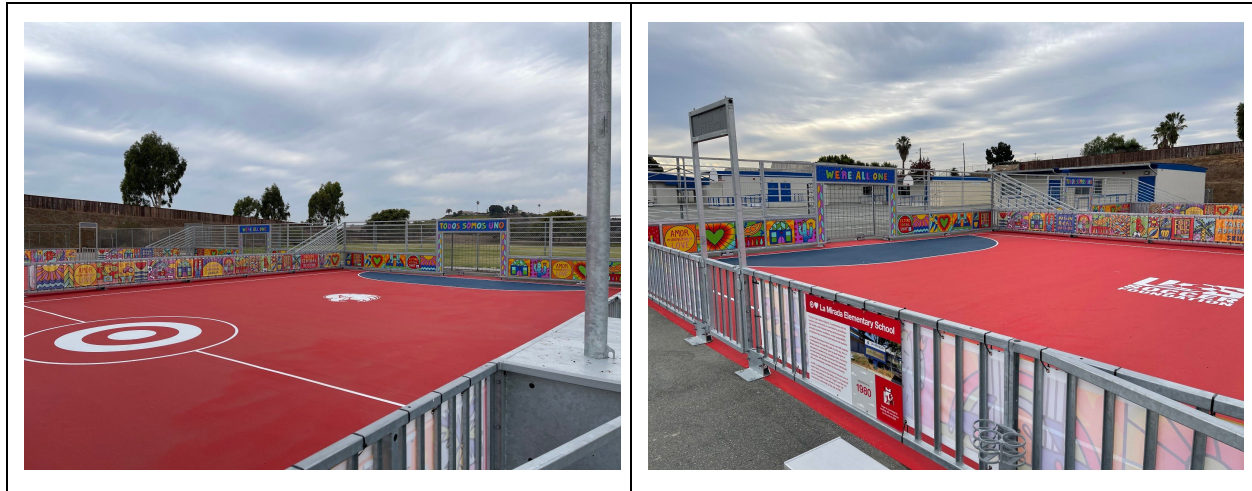

COVID-19 TESTING FOR ALL SCHOOL STAFF

As of March 2020, none of the positive COVID district notification cases have been contact traced back to any of our schools or district facilities with regards to transmission. Thus, our district implemented COVID safety procedures that have been effective within our schools, facilities and our YMCA program. We encourage staff and families to practice COVID safety measures at all times outside of the workplace and schools, which include but are not limited to: face coverings, social distancing,

hand washing, and adherence to state and county health guidance regarding gathering restrictions.

Thanks to the County of San Diego and San Diego County Office of Education, our district staff is able to be tested for COVID-19 safely, and at no cost. As of October 1st, testing sites were opened for school district employees throughout the county.

These sites aim to produce results sooner than 48 hours after an individual is tested. This is helpful as it supports our number one priority of keeping all SYSD schools and facilities safe. All district employees working onsite shall test for COVID-19 every other month. All school districts countywide now have access to these COVID school personnel testing locations. This week SYSD Management Staff will be tested for COVID-19. Our new SYSD testing process is working well and has been well received by everyone.

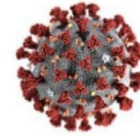

INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM PHASE III PLANNING

While the county remains in the Purple Tier our district plans to continue the Distance Learning Academy for all students. Specialized cohorts are an option for the district to consider while in the Purple Tier. When the county returns to the Red Tier then our district plans to launch the Blended Learning Program.

As the district continues to work through the planning for the launch of Phase III we have finalized numbers for our families who chose Distance Learning or Blended Learning when we launch Phase III. The information from parents indicates that district wide 60% of our families would like Blended Learning and 40% of our families would like to continue in the Distance Learning Academy. Additionally, due to the fact that we have moved into the Purple Tier, we have begun to plan for the potential of specialized cohorts on campuses. The updated Instructional Phases plan will be on the December board meeting agenda as an action item. Please see the chart below:
