### NEW BOARD MEMBERS: INCUMBENT IRENE LOPEZ ,HUMBERTO GURMILAN, AND RUDY LOPEZ TAKING THE OATH OF OFFICE DELIVERED BY ASSEMBLYMEMBER TODD GLORIA

San Ysidro School District welcomed California State Assemblymember Todd Gloria who represents the 78th Assembly District at our Governing Board Meeting this Thursday, December 13th as he helped deliver the Oath of Office to incumbent Irene Lopez and new Board Members Humberto Gurmilan and Rodolfo (Rudy) Lopez. Prior to being an Assemblymember, Mr. Gloria served as a San Diego City Council Member, San Diego Housing Commissioner and District Director for Congresswoman Susan Davis.

Board Member Irene Lopez has served on our Board since her election to a two year term in 2016. Last year she led our district as the Board Vice President and yesterday at our Board Meeting she was nominated as the new Board President. Last month, Board President Irene Lopez was elected to serve a full 4 year term on our Governing Board. Board President Irene Lopez retired from San Ysidro School District after 40 years of dedicated service. She grew up in San Ysidro and attended our schools.

Mrs. Lopez and her husband raised 2 children, Manny and Irene, who also attended San Ysidro School District. She is the proud grandmother of Natasha, who attends Smythe Child Development Center and Eduardo, who is a 7th grader at Vista Del Mar Middle School. Board President Irene Lopez is dedicated to making sure our children receive the best education possible and our teachers and employees have all the tools and respect necessary to help provide that education for our children. We are excited to have Board President Irene Lopez continue to lead our district because she always believes in our schools, our students, our staff and our community and she is always proud of the many great things that we do for our children.



Humberto Gurmilan is an Emmy award winning journalist and producer who spent 14 years in the media. He is also the Founder and Director of The Gurmilan Foundation. His Foundation is dedicated to empowering and helping young people with disabilities to reach their full potential. Mr. Gurmilan is an advocate for creating awareness about disabilities and is frequently asked to speak in the community to spread his positive message of inclusion and hope.

Mr. Gurmilan was born in Chula Vista and grew up in Tijuana. He often visited his grandparents who lived in San Ysidro. He and his parents eventually moved to San Diego where he graduated from Montgomery High School. Mr. Gurmilan received his Associate of Arts degree in Journalism from Southwestern College and a Bachelor of Arts degree in Communications from San Diego State University. He earned a Master's Degree in Communications and wrote a book entitled "From My Chair", also written in Spanish, "Desde Mi Silla". Mr. Gurmilan is a former Sports Anchor at Telemundo 33 and currently is a journalism professor at Southwestern College.

Mr. Gurmilan was nominated to serve our district as the new Board Vice President during the board meeting this week. Board Vice President Gurmilan was surrounded by family and close friends while Assemblymember Todd Gloria administered the oath of office.



Rodolfo (Rudy) Lopez, is a lifelong resident and businessman within our community of San Ysidro. He and his family have lived and worked in San Ysidro for generations. Through their family business, La Bodega Hermanos Lopez, he, along with his family, have helped support many San Ysidro families. He holds a degree in international business and served in the Coast Guard reserves and was sent to work with FEMA (the Federal Emergency Management Agency) during several hurricanes. Mr. Lopez has worked with former City Councilmember David Alvarez to address issues and concerns in San Ysidro.

He was involved in the selection of the current San Ysidro School District Superintendent, Gina Potter and the new Principal at Smythe Elementary, Russell Little. He served as the president of the Smythe Elementary PTA and sits on the Boards of San Ysidro Chamber of Commerce, Border View YMCA and Southwest Little League. Board Member Rudy Lopez also serves on the Sweetwater Union High School District Bond Oversight Committee.

# GROUNDBREAKING CEREMONY: LIVING ROOMS AT THE BORDER (CASA FAMILIAR)


