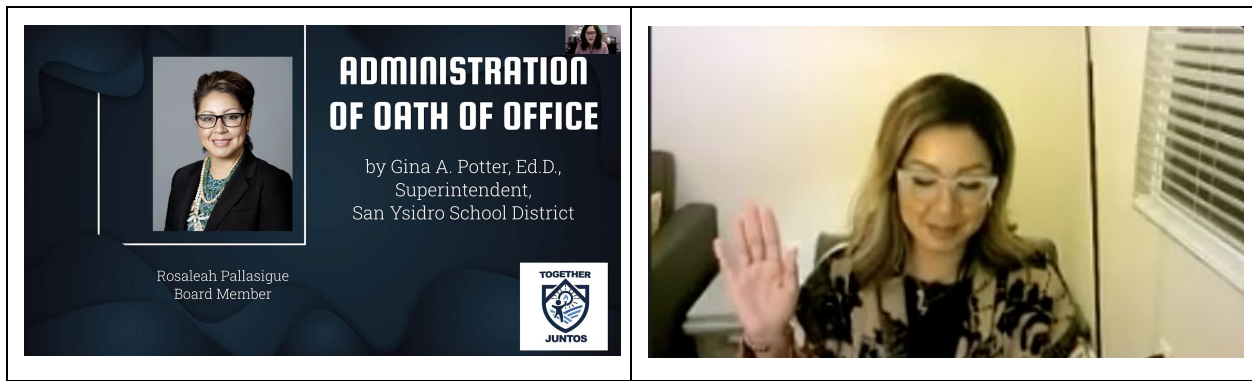

COVID-19 TESTING FOR ALL SCHOOL STAFF

As of March 2020, none of the positive COVID district notification cases have been contact traced back to any of our schools or district facilities with regards to transmission. Our district has implemented COVID safety procedures that have been effective within our schools, facilities and our YMCA program. We encourage staff and families to practice COVID safety measures at all times outside of the workplace and schools, which include but are not limited to: face coverings, social distancing, hand washing, and adherence to state and county health guidance regarding gathering restrictions.

Thanks to the County of San Diego and San Diego County Office of Education, our district staff is able to be tested for COVID-19 safely, and at no cost. As of October 1st, testing sites were opened for school district employees throughout the county.

These sites aim to produce results sooner than 48 hours after an individual is tested. This is helpful as it supports our number one priority of keeping all SYSD schools and facilities safe. All district employees working onsite shall test for COVID-19 every other month. All school districts have access to the free County of San Diego COVID testing locations found on this [link](#).
