COVID CASE DASHBOARD

This Dashboard is an effort for our district to be transparent regarding COVID cases. Our dashboard reflects the number of cases since July 26 and through February 11. Most of these cases have been "contact traced" to places other than school sites. This past week, our schools witnessed a dramatic drop in cases among our students and employees, as compared to prior weeks after winter break. The district's multi-layered safety measures are proving highly effective in curbing the transmission of COVID within our schools.
