
OCEAN VIEW HILLS PRESCHOOL VIRTUAL OPEN HOUSE



WILLOW ELEMENTARY SCHOOL VIRTUAL OPEN HOUSE





COVID CASE DASHBOARD

This Dashboard is an effort for our district to be transparent regarding COVID cases. Our dashboard reflects the number of cases since July 26 and through February 17. Most of these cases have been "contact traced" to places other than school sites. This past week, our schools witnessed a dramatic drop in cases among our students and employees, as compared to prior weeks after winter break. The district's multi-layered safety measures are proving highly effective in curbing the transmission of COVID within our schools.

SDCOE K-12 COMPREHENSIVE HEALTH EDUCATION GRANT

The district has been awarded a \$75,000 mini-grant by the San Diego County Office of Education (SDCOE). The intention is to build our health education program at the elementary school level through professional learning and an understanding of the Health Education Frameworks. We will work with 15 district teachers to include in professional learning, creating curriculum maps for these standards, developing skill based health education lessons/modules in English and Spanish. Then this team will work to implement skill-based health education lessons/modules with students.

BOND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE VACANT SEATS
