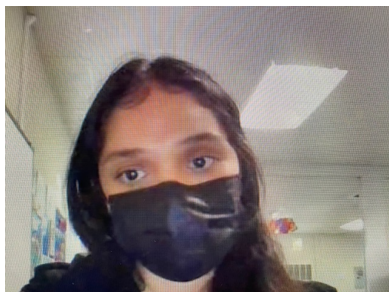
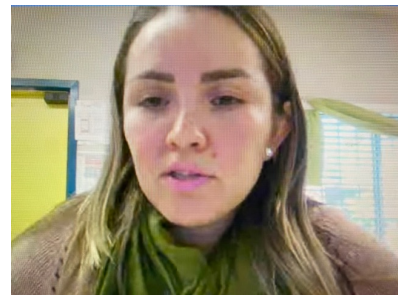

CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER VIRTUAL OPEN HOUSE

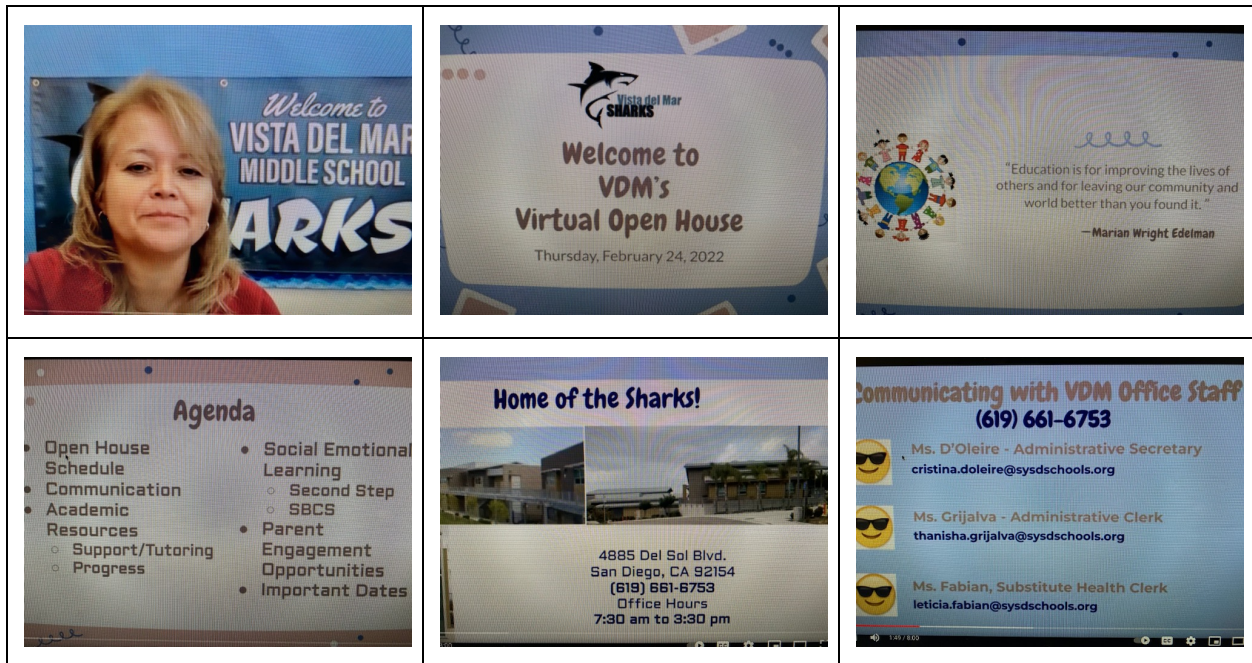

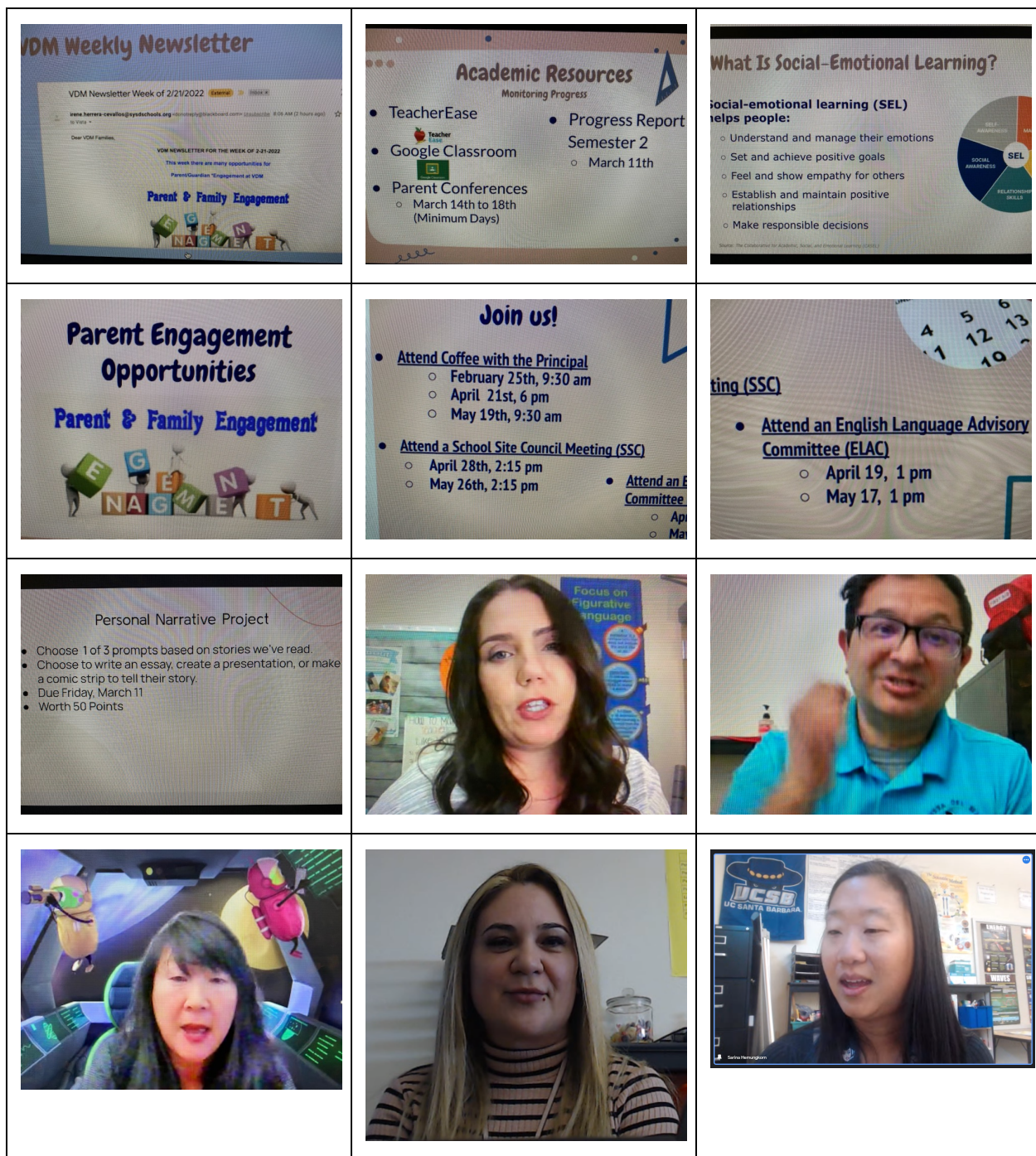




VISTA DEL MAR MIDDLE SCHOOL VIRTUAL OPEN HOUSE

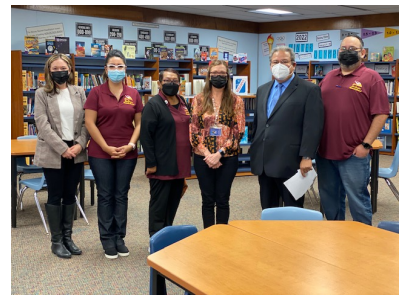
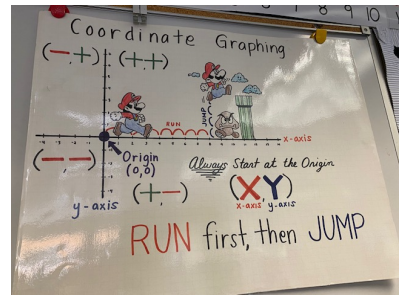
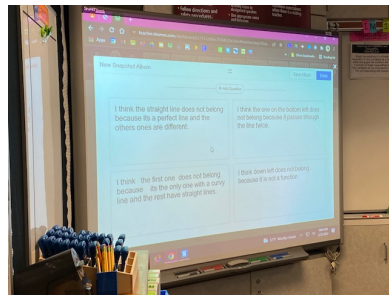
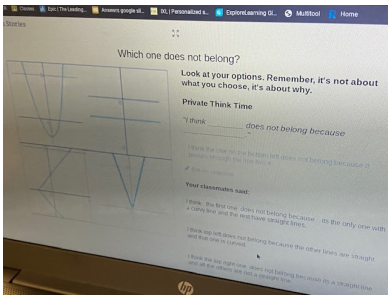
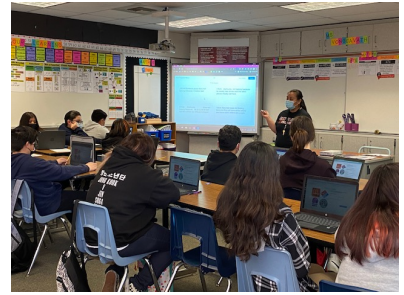
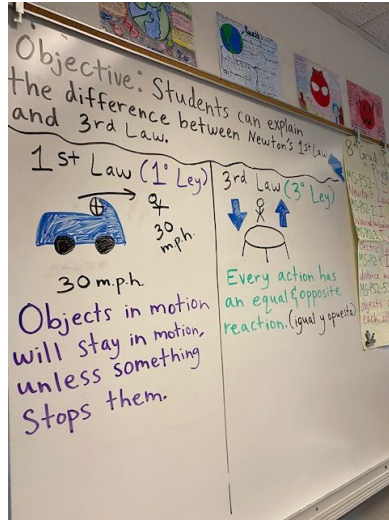
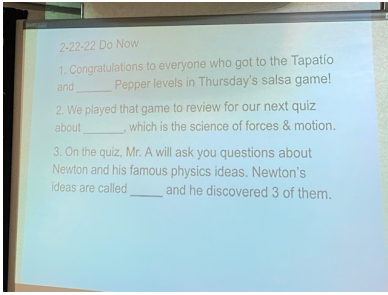
SAN YSIDRO MIDDLE SCHOOL SCHOOL VISIT

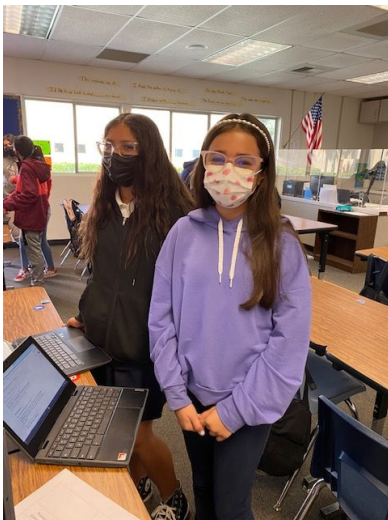
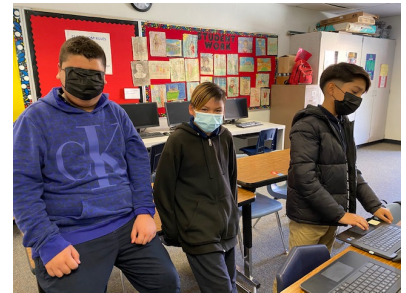
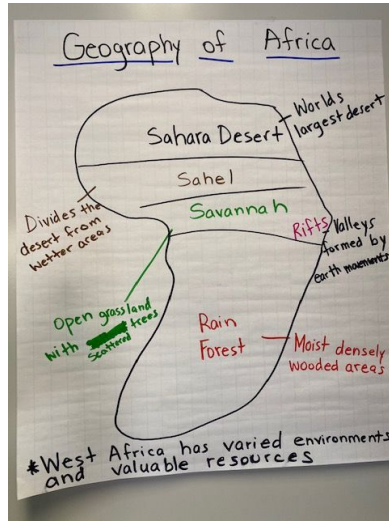

COVID CASE DASHBOARD

This Dashboard is an effort for our district to be transparent regarding COVID cases. Our dashboard reflects the number of cases since July 26 and through February 25. Most of these cases have been “contact traced” to places other than school sites. This past week, our schools again witnessed a dramatic drop in cases among our students and employees, as compared to prior weeks after winter break. The district’s multi-layered safety measures are proving highly effective in curbing the transmission of COVID within our schools. At the March Governing Board Meeting, outdoor masking and amending the COVID-19 Safety Plan will be an agenda item.
