

# BOARD RECOGNITION/DISTINGUISHED CHAMPION: DISTRICT FEDERAL PROGRAM MONITORING (FPM) TEAM

The Governing Board and Superintendent Potter recognized the entire District Federal Program Monitoring Audit Team at the April 15, 2021 Regular Board Meeting. The Federal Program Monitoring Review was conducted by the California Department of Education. This year the review included five categories: Compensatory Education (Title I), Supporting Effective Instruction (Title II), English Learner (Title III), School Support and Improvement (Comprehensive School Improvement Grant) and Homeless Education. FPM is a comprehensive review that includes evidentiary document requests across all district level departments. Additionally, two schools were selected to be part of the FPM audit: Sunset and San Ysidro Middle School. In late February 2021, the district was notified that the audit resulted in zero findings. A big congratulations goes out to the entire team.

Mr. Mata read the email that was sent by the Jessica Gray, Review Team Lead - Federal Program Monitoring Office for the California Department of Education:

"This review included over 70 items across five programs, and nearly 150 evidence requests requiring detailed response. To have zero findings result from an FPM review is rare, and is a testament to your leadership in this process, as well as to the systems you have in place in the district. Thank you again."

The Governing Board and Superintendent Potter acknowledged Executive Director of Educational Services Cynthia Monreal Gonzalez and the Resource Teachers who coordinated and gathered the information for the review and all the departments that provided the details that resulted in zero finding results. The departments that contributed were: Educational Services, Pupil Services, Human Resources, Business Services, Education Technology, Special Education, Sunset Elementary School and San Ysidro Middle School.







# BOARD RECOGNITION/DISTINGUISHED CHAMPION: DISTRICT VIRTUAL EVENT & ZOOM PLANNERS

The Governing Board recognized Director of Education Technology Todd Lewis and Administrative Confidential Secretary Miguel Ortega at the April 15, 2021 Regular Board Meeting.

Director of Education Technology Todd Lewis has been one of the leaders during this pandemic. His department has worked with staff and families in making sure that they have computers, internet connectivity and hot spots. He coordinated many Chromebook distribution events within the district. 

# BOARD PRESENTATION: LONG RANGE MASTER FACILITY PLAN BY WLC ARCHITECTS, INC., PRESIDENT, JIM DICAMILLO

Over the past year, Mr. DiCamillo and the district have spoken with and received input from District staff (both certificated and classified), administrators, families and community members. Multiple meetings were held with each school site; some in person but most through virtual platforms. The district hosted five community forums to gather stakeholder input and conducted surveys throughout the entire school district and community. All along the way, the District has listened to and built upon that input so that we believe our 2021 Facilities Master Plan is a truly inclusive roadmap for our foreseeable facilities future. The first draft of the Long Range Master Facility Plan was presented to the Board this past Thursday by Jim DiCamillo with WLC Architects.
