SOUTHWEST VILLAGE PLANNING GROUP MEETING

On Wednesday, April 17th the following representatives from our district attended the Southwest Village Planning Group Meeting: Board Vice President Gurmilan, Board Member Rudy Lopez, CBO Marilyn Adrianzen, Director of MOTF Paulo Azevedo and myself. During the meeting it was shared that Pardee Homes is projecting about 1,841 elementary students and 471 middle school students to move into the new home development they are building. Pardee has set aside a 10 acre lot for a school and a joint use park. They noted a 2nd school may be needed.

SAN YSIDRO MIDDLE SCHOOL 7TH GRADE INTERNSHIP DAY AT OUTLETS AT THE BORDER - APRIL 18, 2019

Over 150 7th grade students from San Ysidro Middle School participated in the 7th Grade Internship Day at the Outlets, coordinated by the San Ysidro Chamber of Commerce Education Committee led by Cynthia Nagura and hosted by the San Ysidro Outlets and their General Manager, Andres Ripa. About 10 different businesses and administration divisions of the outlets volunteered to be a part of this exciting program for students! They volunteered resources, staff and products to make this a special career day for our middle school students! Information Sheet for 7th grade Internship Day at San Diego Outlets at the Border

<u>Purpose of Visit</u>: This is the 5th annual 7th grade Internship Day at San Diego Outlets at the Border. We will have 120 7th grade students from San Ysidro Middle School participate. The Internship Day is intended to allow students to get first-hand experience on how a business functions, learn about some of the positions/personnel required to have a successful operation of a mall, connect skills that are learned in the classroom to skills needed to be successful in the workforce, start thinking about future plans after high school and what careers they may want to explore. Students will also learn about the connection of going to school/college and how this impacts choices for jobs/careers in their adult life.

<u>Background Information:</u> Students attending the Internship Day are from San Ysidro Middle School. San Ysidro Middle School is one of two middle schools in the San Ysidro School District. The majority of students are English Language Learners and are at different levels in English proficiency. About 99% of our students are Latino and the majority are bilingual in English and Spanish.

<u>Preparation of Students:</u> Students have been prepared by teachers in the classroom and during an internship day training. Students know what to expect during the visit. Student will be given a worksheet (attached) to fill out during each of the visits, and a list of questions so that they can be engaged during the presentation. Students will begin the Internship Day at San Ysidro Middle School with a presentation on the Priority Industry Sectors in San Diego. The presentation will be given by Jose Rivera, Project Specialist, from Work Based Learning Department of the San Diego County Office of Education.

Expectations from Presenters: Students will be divided into groups of 12 and will attend two businesses/departments. Presenters are expected to define key terms that are used during their presentation (ie. profit, marketing, customer service, budget, product standards, tenate, etc.). Presenters are to make the presentation as interactive as possible and hands-on to connect skills that students learn in the classroom/school to skills needed in the workforce (verbal skills, math skills, soft skills, communication, following directions, dress code, punctuality, etc.). When possible, students will role play and practice skills needed (ie. eye contact, shaking hands, greeting clients, etc.) as part of their experience during the Internship Day.




































INDEPENDENT CITIZENS' OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE DEVELOPMENT TIMELINE
