








2021-22 SUPERINTENDENT STUDENT ADVISORY COUNCIL

ACSA VICE PRESIDENTS OF LEGISLATIVE ACTION LED BY SUPERINTENDENT POTTER

Superintendent Potter led the final 2021-22 ACSA state Vice Presidents for Legislative Action session on Wednesday, May 11th during the ACSA State Leadership Assembly event. ACSA's Senior Director of Policy and Governmental Relations and incoming Executive Director, Dr. Edgar Zazueta provided a state legislative update along with legislative advocates from the Governmental Relations team in Sacramento. The Vice Presidents for Legislative Action (VPLA) also celebrated the amazing success of this year's Legislative Action Days event held in April wherein 473 educational leaders statewide advocated on behalf of education by meeting with over 70 legislative leaders from both the Senate and the Assembly! Educational policy topics advocated for included: School Finance (boost core funding, COVID attendance relief, pension liabilities, & more), Remove Obstacles to UTK Expansion, Non Prop 98 Facilities Funding, Return Educators back to Educating, and Region Specific Topics.



SUPERINTENDENT POTTER SWORN IN AS ACSA STATE VPLA 2022-23

On Thursday, May 12th Superintendent Potter was honored to participate as a state ACSA Executive Board Member in the Executive Committee meeting and the Leadership Assembly. During these meetings ACSA provided educational leaders with professional development on equity, trained on utilizing Thought Exchange as a meaningful survey tool that aggregates data, reviewed the strategic plan and legislative priorities, and conducted the installation of 2022-23 Board of Directors.
