

CLASSROOMS OF THE FUTURE (CFF): 22ND ANNUAL INNOVATION IN EDUCATION AWARDS

On Thursday, May 15, 2025, the Classroom of the Future Foundation (CFF) hosted its 22nd Annual Innovation in Education Awards at SeaWorld San Diego, celebrating outstanding programs across San Diego County that received this year's Inspire, Innovate, Achieve, and Impact Awards. The event recognized exceptional efforts that are reshaping education and student experiences.



The San Ysidro School District was honored with the prestigious 2025 Inspire Award for its Moderate/Severe Special Education STEAM Program facilitated by the Sci Phy Program Team. Launched in 2022, the program was created to address a critical gap in STEAM education for students with special needs. The program offers weekly, hands-on sessions in robotics, coding, science, and art. Designed to be inclusive and sensory-friendly, the program empowers students to engage in creative exploration, critical thinking, and problem-solving.


SAN YSIDRO MIDDLE SCHOOL VISIT
















MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS MONTH
