VISTA DEL MAR MIDDLE SCHOOL EARN THE NO PLACE FOR HATE DESIGNATION

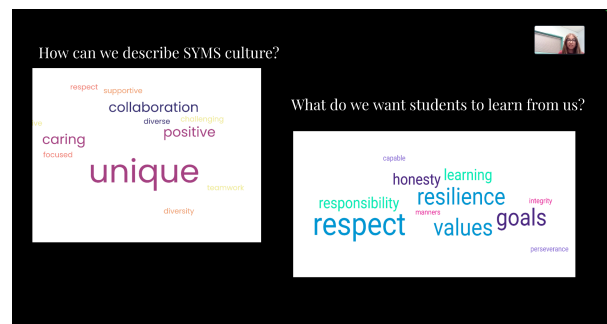

PRESCHOOL FUN FITNESS FRIDAY

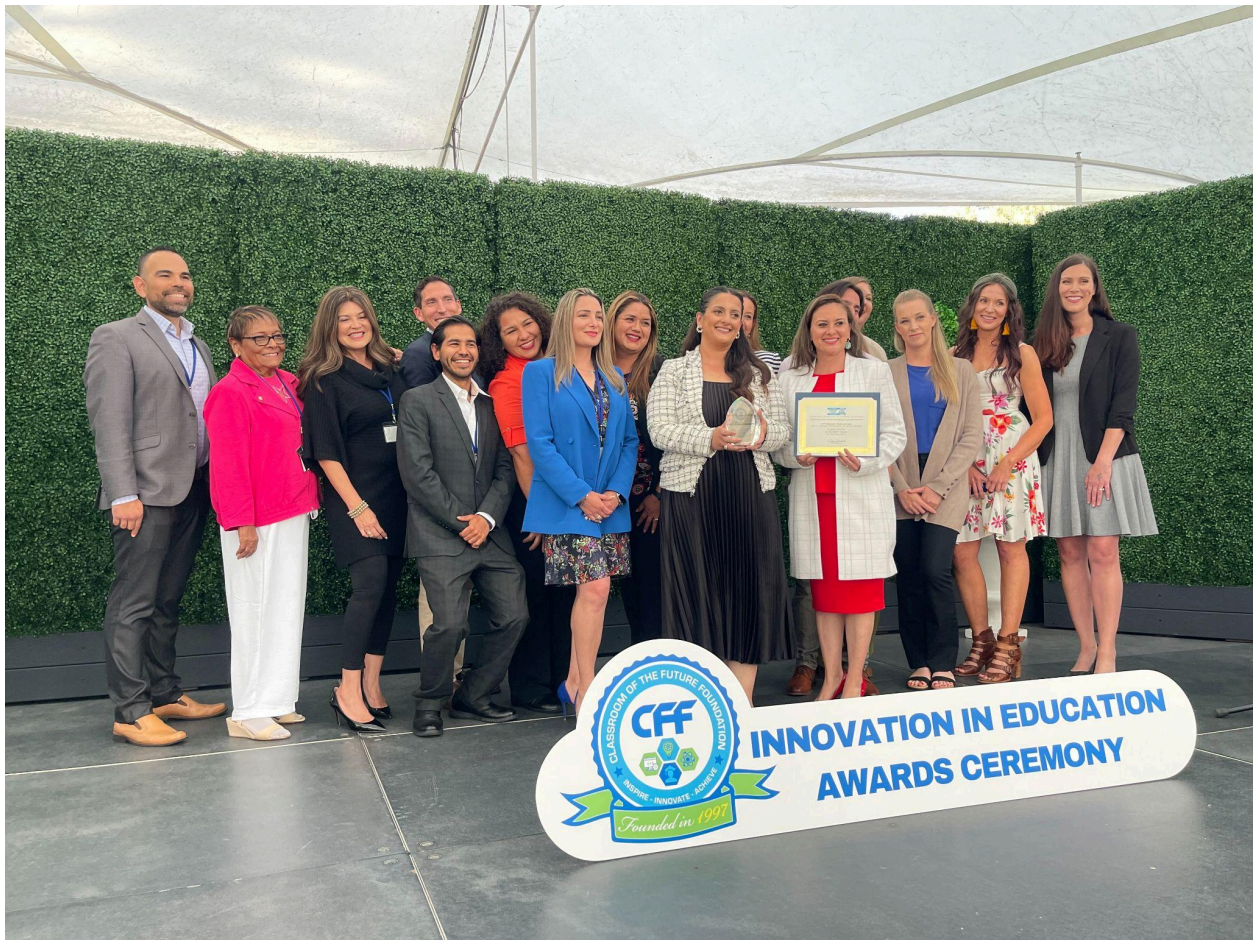
Last week, the Child Development Center had Preschool Fun Fitness Friday. Students participated in relay races, obstacle courses, and stretching activities to promote physical fitness.



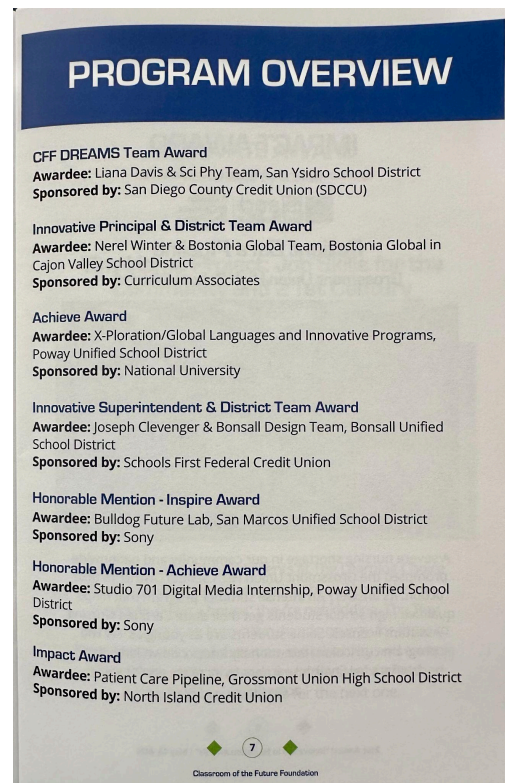
SCI PHY PROGRAM WINS THE CLASSROOM OF THE FUTURE FOUNDATION 2024 DREAMS TEAM AWARD

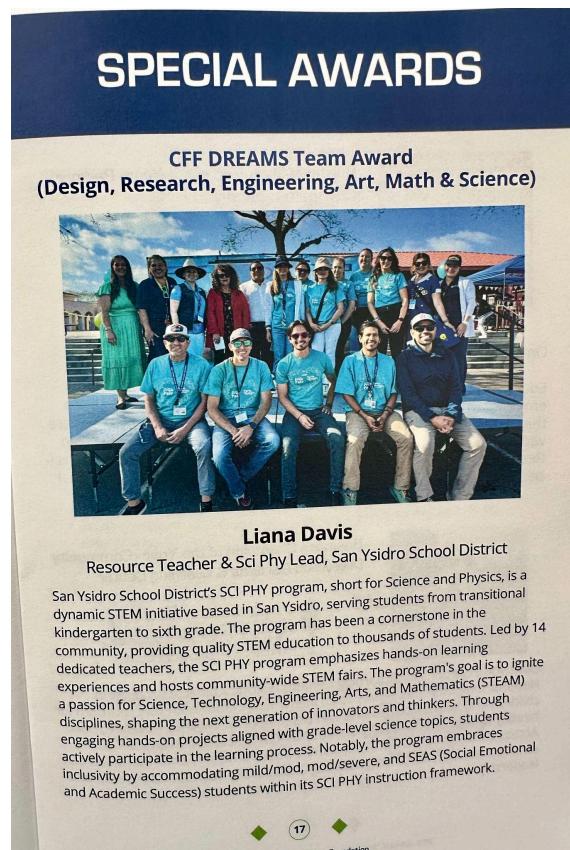
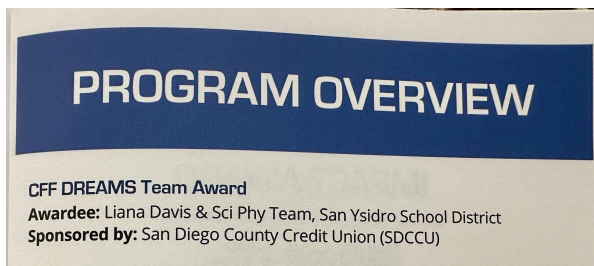
