
#### SMYTHE CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER - DIA DEL NIÑO

#### CALIFORNIA LEGISLATIVE STAFF EDUCATION INSTITUTE - SYSD FALL VISIT

Our district has been one of the select few districts statewide selected by the California Legislative Staff Education Institute (CLSEI) to be visited in the fall 2019! They will either visit our district on Oct 23-25 or Nov 6-8.

"The CLSEI provides specially tailored education and relationship-building programs to legislative staff from both houses, both parties, and the Legislative Analyst's Office. The Institute assembles policy-focused legislative staff cohorts and connects them to stakeholders impacted by state policies, including local officials, private and non-profit partners, community groups, and program recipients. Interactive site visits explore the data, implementation approaches, and outcomes in different communities.

In 2006, with funding from the Gates, Hewlett, and Irvine foundations, Capitol Impact established an educational program to substantially improve the Legislature's capacity for fact-based, data-driven, contextualized policy by strengthening the knowledge base and professional networks among legislative staff. Originally focused on K-12 education, the Institute currently serves over 200 legislative staff working in seven key policy areas: Economic Development; the Environment; Governand & Fiscal Policy; Health Policy & Finance; Human Services; Higher Education, and K-12 Education."
