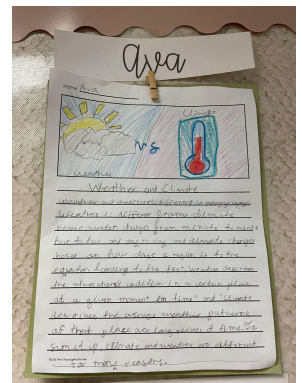
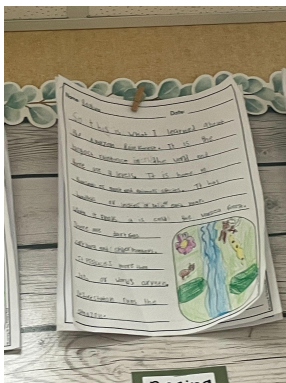
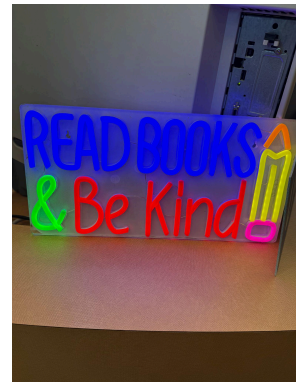
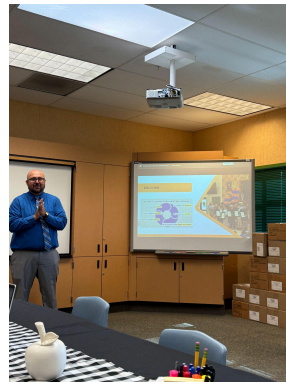
SUNSET ELEMENTARY SCHOOL VISIT

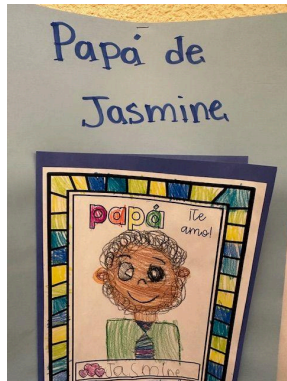
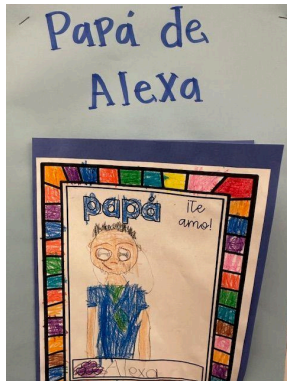

SAN YSIDRO MIDDLE SCHOOL ART GALLERY

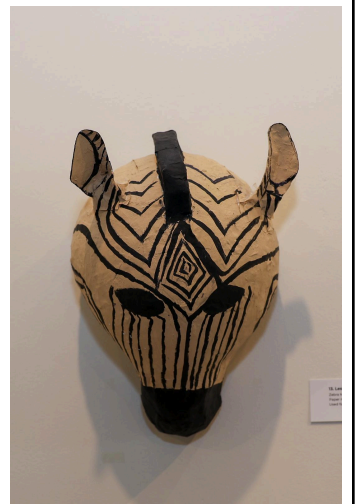
The Front Gallery at San Ysidro Middle School was a vibrant celebration of student creativity and interdisciplinary learning. Showcasing projects from Art, Computer Science, Journalism, and Social Studies electives, the exhibit reflected the school's commitment to a well-rounded and engaging education.

Students in the Art elective displayed striking Op Art paintings and visual perception pieces that played with depth, color blending, and light and shadow to create dynamic three-dimensional effects.

In the Journalism and Computer Science electives, students demonstrated their digital design skills using GIMP (GNU Image Manipulation Program). By combining original photography with stock images, they produced surreal compositions, digital murals, virtual collages, and product photography that highlighted their technical proficiency and creative expression.

The 7th-grade Social Studies projects explored the cultural and historical significance of African masks. Students studied the role of masks in rituals and social customs across various cultures and created their own masks using recycled and household materials, applying both critical thinking and artistic ingenuity.
