Dear Parents/Guardians:

We would like to welcome you to the 2020-2021 online registration period. We will open the online registration system on May 15th for the 2020-2021 school year. This year, the online registration process will be for all students from Preschool – Grade 8. The process for enrollment will vary for current San Ysidro School District families and families that are enrolling students for the first time in the district.

To complete online registration, you will need to go to the district website, Online Registration Page: https://www.sysdschools.org/domain/740. From this page you will find step by step instructions to follow for online enrollment, you will also find contact information by school site if you need support with an activation code or log-in information for registration. We have included help documents with this letter to support you as you prepare to register your child/children for the 2020-2021 school year.

Prompt enrollment of your child/children is important for the planning of the upcoming school year. As soon as you register and submit your verification documents, we will be able to plan for student placement at our school sites. We make every effort to enroll students at their school of residence first, however, please keep in mind that after June 15th, we will begin the process of approving student transfer requests, and will approve placement at school sites based on the enrollment numbers.

This year due to the world health pandemic and to maintain safety and health guidelines outlined by the county and state we are required to practice social distancing guidelines. With that in mind we have created a virtual process for registration and the submission of forms required to complete enrollment. You will be able to complete the entire process online and upload all required documents through our online registration system. If you do not have access at home to complete online registration, we will have some community registration events available, please see the enclosed flyer with more detailed information.
