SAN YSIDRO WOMEN'S CLUB DISTRIBUTES SCHOLARSHIPS AND INCENTIVE AWARDS

This year the San Ysidro Woman's Club distributed \$33,700 in scholarships and incentive awards to San Ysidro High School seniors and graduating 8th graders from San Ysidro Middle School and Vista Del Mar Middle School. The \$31,000 in scholarships for the 19 graduating seniors at San Ysidro High School ranged from \$5,000 to \$1,000 each. The \$2,700 incentive awards were distributed to 27 eighth grade recipients who each received an envelope containing a crisp, new \$100 bill to help them with their transition to high school.

LOCAL CONTROL and ACCOUNTABILITY PLAN (LCAP) UPDATE

The proposed LCAP was presented at the board meeting on Thursday, June 10th, in conjunction with the public hearing for LCAP approval that is required per statute and gives stakeholders the opportunity to make public comments on the proposed LCAP ahead of the approval of the plan. The LCAP will be finalized and brought to the board for final approval as an action item on the June 24th board meeting agenda. Based on stakeholder feedback and data analysis, the proposed LCAP includes 5 goals for the 2021-2024 LCAP, focused on the following topics:

1. Student Achievement
2. English Language Proficiency
3. Safety, Climate, and Student Engagement
4. Social Emotional Support & Wellbeing
5. Parent Engagement

SCI PHY PROGRAM

The district is so proud to continue to offer our elementary school students the Sci Phy Program. This program is designed to provide students with a weekly class including a hands-on science program using Project Lead the Way (PLTW) modules and Physical Education, with embedded social emotional learning and academic language acquisition support. During this pandemic year, our Sci-Phy teachers, transitioned a hands-on program to be delivered 100% virtually and we could not have done that without the hard work of our teachers and the support of our families. Families in Motion is a collaborative program designed to help educate teens and their parents on issues confronting teenagers today.

- Five-week *virtual* program, Tuesday evenings, 5:30-7:30 p.m.
- Parents and students participate virtually via Zoom.
- Topics to be covered include navigating COVID-19 stressors, the dangers of social media and human trafficking, drugs, and gangs.
- Additional community resources are offered to families participating in the program such as food, clothing, housing, and counseling.
- At the conclusion of the program, both teens and parents receive a certificate of participation, and students may also receive community service credit.
