SUPERINTENDENT

CDC, CDE, CDPH & COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT GUIDANCE FOR REOPENING SCHOOLS

Within the last two weeks the Centers for Disease Control, the California Department of Education and the California Department of Public Health have issued guidance for reopening schools within the state of California. Additionally, the county health department issued a health order on June 9th indicating that within certain social distancing, sanitation, health and safety guidelines schools within San Diego county can reopen as early as June 12th with a reopening of schools plan.

Our **Reopening of Schools Task Force** is reviewing all of these guidelines this summer in order to craft a written Reopening of Schools Plan for our district so we can reopen safely for the new school year in mid-August, likely with a blended learning model (partial week in school & partial week distance learning).



In preparation for the 2020-2021 school year, we have launched a reopening schools task force to develop the guiding principles for reopening with a focus on creating a safe and healthy environment for students, staff and families, accelerating learning, providing social-emotional support, and increased family engagement. The task force has specific sub-committees whose work will focus on the various aspects of reopening, these sub-committees include: facilities/transportation, school logistics, instruction, community & parent engagement, and business/child nutrition.
