







LA MIRADA AND SMYTHE DRIVE THROUGH RESOURCE FAIR

EDUCATIONAL LEADERSHIP, PUPIL SERVICES AND SAFETY

REQUIREMENTS FOR 2021-2022 VIRTUAL LEARNING ACADEMY

The Virtual Learning Academy will require families and students to view the online Virtual Learning Academy Orientation (link available below) and complete and submit the Virtual Learning Academy Contract (available below) by June 8, 2021.

The district strongly encourages families to consider placing their child in the full in person learning program next school year as the research indicates that most students learn best at school. Students who participate next year in the Virtual Learning Academy will be required to maintain positive attendance, engagement and academic proficiency. Students who struggle within the Virtual Learning Academy may be placed by the district in the full in person instructional program at the end of an elementary school trimester or middle school semester period to ensure their academic success.

NOTE: The state Legislature is deliberating whether or not Kindergarten through Third grades will be permitted to participate in Virtual Learning Programs next year. Families of K-3 students may apply for the Virtual Learning Program with the understanding that the district is awaiting state guidance regarding eligibility for online learning for these grades.














SAN YSIDRO SCHOOL DISTRICT SUMMER VACCINATION EVENTS

During the San Ysidro Education Collaborative Meeting on May 19th, Deputy District Attorney General Marissa Bejarano shared the flyer for the next series of workshops for Parents & Teens. This series has been very highly recommended.



Families in Motion is a collaborative program designed to help educate teens and their parents on issues confronting teenagers today.

- Five-week virtual program, Tuesday evenings, 5:30-7:30 p.m.
- Parents and students participate virtually via 700m
- Topics to be covered include navigating COVID-19 stressors, the dangers of social media and human trafficking, drugs, and gangs.
- Additional community resources are offered to families participating in the program such as food, clothing, housing, and counseling.
- At the conclusion of the program, both teens and parents receive a certificate of participation, and students may also receive community service credit.
