### **EXTENDED SCHOOL YEAR SUMMER SPECIAL EDUCATION PROGRAM** (Oscar Madera, Director of Special Education)

Students were also introduced to Mind-Up which is a mindfulness curriculum that will be adopted this year in all of our special education classrooms around the San Ysidro School District. # **SUMMER CAREER PATHWAYS PROGRAM** (Omar Calleros, Coordinator, Community Schools & After School Programs)

This Summer, students from the San Ysidro community had an opportunity to explore several career opportunities by attending the Pathways Summer Career Exploration program, a 4 week long program. Each week was themed with a different career path for all students grades K-8 to consider. Their week was filled with guest speakers from sector industries and activities to go along with those visits. In addition, every Thursday San Ysidro students traveled to a San Diego university to get an early start on college education. Lead by Barrio Logan College Institute, students visited: SDSU, USD and UCSD.

After a fun and educational Thursday, students experienced a second field trip every Friday as well. Every Friday students visited their guest speakers at their work site, to have a hands on experience. students visited industries focused on; healthcare, building and carpenter union, science, pharmacy, electrician, TV production and the Ruben H. Fleet Science Center! In partnership with our Nutrition department, all students received free breakfast and free lunch as well.
