A MESSAGE FROM THE SUPERINTENDENT: WELCOME BACK TO SCHOOL

July 19, 2021

Dear San Ysidro School District Families,

I extend a warm welcome back to our students and families for the 2021-2022 school year. This will be a year of transition as our district works in partnership with our families to support the vast majority of our students to return to full in person instruction in our schools. Our team is sensitive to the significant impact the COVID pandemic has had in our community and in our schools this past year. With this in mind, our Governing Board has identified the theme of the year as "Adelante" or "Onward" paired with the

goals of safety, social emotional support and wellbeing, student achievement, English language proficiency, parent engagement and student engagement.

We are deeply grateful to our families, district staff and community for uniting this last year to save lives, to support families with resources, and to ensure our students had equitable access to a quality education amidst the pandemic. We are proud of this past year's successes wherein together we maintained the second highest student enrollment in the county, our nutrition team served 785,604 meals, our Sci-Phy team won national distinction with an Innovation in Education Inspire Award for their Project Lead the Way Program, our district earned perfect external and federal program monitoring audits, our student achievement data regarding learning loss appears one to three times better than preliminary state and federal data, and we closed the digital divide and ensured every student has access to a device and/or internet.

Our District is working together as a strong united team to implement our vision and mission which focus on student achievement.

The first day of school for all students is Monday, July 26th. Schools are sending information to families this week welcoming students back to school and indicating how parents/guardians can find their child's teacher assignment. Additionally, some schools may also be providing a back to school orientation. If your family does not receive notification from your child's school by Thursday of this week, please call or visit your school's office for support as soon as possible. Schools are unable to place a student in a class or provide classroom teacher information to families that have not yet registered their child for school or have not submitted verification of residency information. All school offices and the district office are now open Monday through Friday to assist families with student registration, verification of residency, before and after school program applications, school uniforms, Chromebooks, and more.

School uniforms will continue to be required in all of our schools, however our district is providing a 3 week grace period (July 26 - Aug 13) to allow families sufficient time to purchase uniforms. The school uniforms may be purchased at any store of your choice and consist of: navy blue bottoms (pants, skirt or shorts) and a white polo shirt. As we open our schools for full in person instruction safety remains a priority for our federal, state, county and district leaders. The leading public health prevention strategy is vaccination to end the COVID-19 pandemic. San Diego county continues to serve as a leader with some of the highest vaccination rates statewide. In addition, our district's maintenance, operations, transportation and facilities team has done a remarkable job ensuring all schools and departments have multi-layered safety measures in place. The district continues to follow the California Department for Public Health safety measures for schools and child care programs, which were recently updated. These safety measures currently include: upgraded ventilation systems with air purification systems, masks indoors when students are present, hand washing/sanitizing, quarantine guidelines, and symptomatic COVID testing. UPDATED SYSD COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN

On July 12, 2021, the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) released its 2021-22 K-12 School Guidance.

This new release came on the heels of CDC's <u>Guidance for COVID-19 Prevention in K-12 Schools</u>.

Building on CDC's outline of the various mitigation strategies schools should implement to stop the spread of COVID-19, CDPH's guidance addresses masking, quarantine directives for both vaccinated and unvaccinated students and staff who may have been exposed to COVID-19, hand hygiene, air filtration, and more.

This CSP is designed to control exposures to the SARS-CoV-2 virus that may occur in our workplace. We will use these requirements and protocol to communicate with all district staff, students and families for a safe and successful 2021-2022 school year.
