CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR'S "BLUEPRINT FOR A SAFER ECONOMY"

On August 28th, the Governor announced a new county-by-county reopening framework that will replace the state's current county monitoring list. The "Blueprint for a Safer Economy" is a four tiered system of monitoring criteria and restricted activities.

County risk level	New cases	Positive tests
WIDESPREAD Most schools are closed to in-person instruction, unless they meet certain conditions	More than 7 daily new cases (per 100k)	More than 8% positive tests
SUBSTANTIAL Schools can reopen for in-person instruction after they have remained in the red tier for 14 days	4 - 7 daily new cases (per 100k)	5 - 8% positive tests
MODERATE Schools can reopen for in-person instruction based on state and county guidance	1 - 3.9 daily new cases (per 100k)	2 - 4.9% positive tests
MINIMAL Schools can reopen for in-person instruction based on state and county guidance	Less than 1 daily new cases (per 100k)	Less than 2% positive tests

Schools are able to reopen when their county moves from the purple "widespread" tier to the "substantial" (red) tier if they meet the established health state criteria for 14 consecutive days and remain below the purple tier for 14 days. Schools also need to follow industry guidance when they reopen which is reflected in our district and school COVID-19 Prevention Safety Plans posted on their websites.

Schools located in counties that are on the purple "widespread" tier may not reopen for in-person instruction unless they are granted an elementary school waiver from their local public health department. Schools may, however, still provide in-person targeted services and support to students under the state's cohorting guidance.

San Diego County is in the red tier. County health officials allowed all schools to reopen as early as Tuesday, September 1st with a COVID-19 Prevention Plan for Schools. At this time our school district remains in Phase I of our three instructional program phases which includes a Distance Learning Academy for all students at least until the end of September. Phase II which will begin in October includes our district continuing to offer a Distance Learning Academy for all students with limited childcare, virtual tutoring and in-person opportunities for targeted students by identified need. On September 10th, the district's Governing Board will discuss the start date for our schools to move into Phase III which provides both a Distance Learning Academy and a Blended Learning Program (2 days at school & 3 days online).




COVID SAFETY SIGNAGE DECALS AND TEMPERATURE CHECKING FOR FRONT OFFICES

The district's maintenance and operation teams have been hard at work ensuring that our students, staff and families are safe and healthy. This team has been placing safety decals and signage at all sites and the district office. They have also installed a temperature checking system in the front of every site office and at the district office main entrance. Additionally, thermoscans for all schools are being installed as walk through temperature checking devices that have a screening capability of 70 people per minute. The thermoscans will be used for our Blended Learning Program to allow for students to flow through the school COVID safety check point quickly each morning.
