households, providing the basis for <u>reapportioning congressional seats</u>, redistricting, and distributing more than \$675 billion in federal funds annually to support states, counties and communities' vital programs — impacting housing, education, transportation, employment, health care and public policy.

Activities being offered at all school sites are unique from other schools. But they have plenty in common, they are all fun, safe and offer a caring environment for our students.


