DRAFT COVID-19 PREVENTION PLAN FOR SCHOOLS

Our gratitude is extended to the district’s Reopening of Schools Task Force as they worked through summer to ensure that our district has a detailed safety plan for our schools. The Task Force utilized the guidance from the California Department of Public Health, the California Department of Education and the county health department as the foundation for safely reopening our schools. Recently, the county health department and the San Diego County Office of Education updated the COVID safety plan template for schools. Our district’s Executive Director of Curriculum and Instruction, Manuela Colom provided the following draft of our district’s COVID-19 Prevention Plan for District/Schools at the board meeting on July 28th.

The next iteration of the COVID-19 Prevention Plan will be brought to the August 13th board meeting and then will be posted on the district and individual school websites. Note, the county of San Diego's health department in conjunction with the San Diego County Office of Education have noted that the template will continue to be updated based on changes made within future state and county health official guidance and orders. Thus, the district and schools will continue to update this safety plan based on changing health official guidance as it is released.
