


WILLOW SCHOOL - VIRTUAL OPEN HOUSE EVENT

Thank you Rudy Lopez for serving as a spokesman for our community and advocating for equity in reducing harmful emissions and improving the air quality in San Ysidro.



We have great news! All SYSD school teachers and staff and district office staff members are now eligible to make COVID vaccine appointments through the VEBA vaccine portal after you receive an email inviting you to schedule your appointment. PHASE III INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM OPTIONS, REOPENING GUIDELINES, SENATE BILL 86 AND MORE

The Governing Board approved on March 4th the amendment of the 2020-2021 Phase III Instructional Programs to expand the instructional program options dependent upon state guidelines for school reopening, staffing availability, resources, and the district receiving the In Person Instruction state Grant funds, and additional federal stimulus funds. Phase III instructional program options may include, if staffing is available: 1) Continuation of the Distance Learning Academy; 2) Various Hybrid or Blended Learning

Programs; and 3) Expanded Specialized Cohorts for At-Risk Students. Phase III Instructional Program in-person options will allow for a phased in approach that adheres to state school reopening guidelines.

WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH



FREE MEAL PROGRAM FOR ALL CHILDREN 1 TO 18 YEARS OLD

There is an important change in SCHEDULE FOR OUR FREE MEAL PROGRAM. We will offer Free Meal pick up at 2 SCHOOLS ONLY: Willow Elementary and La Mirada Elementary. San Ysidro Middle School will no longer distribute meals. Meals are for all children 1 to 18 years old which includes breakfast & lunch for multiple days distributed each week.
