




EVERY ABSENCE MATTERS

PARENT WORKSHOPS OFFERED DURING COFFEE WITH THE PRINCIPAL

The Special Education Department has launched their parent workshops during Coffee with the Principal at all of our school sites. These workshops have been focused on Mental Health and Positive Behavior Intervention Supports (PBIS) with the intention of strengthening our partnership with families in improving student outcomes.

Ms. Karina Victorino, School Social Worker, is presenting for our district parents at Coffee with the Principals at the different schools. So far she has presented at Smythe, Sunset, La Mirada and San Ysidro Middle School. She will continue presenting at different schools during the months of September and October. Ms. Victorino was also invited to present on this topic to the parents of San Ysidro and neighboring communities at "Cafecito con CASA Familiar" on September 15th. Her presentation educates parents on how to identify the warning signs of suicide, tips on how to support their children, the protocol and interventions that our School District follows when one of our students is experiencing a crisis and community and school resources available to support our children and families.





Ms. Marianna Rochin, Behavior Specialist, is presenting at Coffee With The Principals around the district. So far she has presented at OVH and Willow, and her next presentation will be at Sunset Elementary on October 5, 2022. Her presentation provides information to parents about what Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) is and how our schools are using PBIS to build positive school cultures. She includes the importance and benefits of using PBIS and provides strategies for parents to use at home to support the work our schools are doing.
