Transitional Kinder Program Options for Families

- 1. **Regular TK** Register at school site (8:30am 1pm)
- 2. **Extended TK Option 1** (OVH only) -Requires an application for **Preschool** in addition to TK Registration. TK registration is the same (TK 8:30am-1pm & PK to 1-4pm)
- 3. **Extended TK Option 2** Requires an application for **ASES** in addition to TK Registration (TK 8:30am-1pm & ASES 1-5:30pm and space is limited at OVH)

Middle schools have scheduled orientations for students as noted below.

Orientation for Vista Del Mar Middle School: Thursday, July 24, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. for 6th grade students and at 1:00 p.m. for new students, 7th grade, and 8th grade students.

Orientation for San Ysidro Middle School: Thursday, July 24, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. for 7th grade and new students and at 1:00 p.m. for 8th grade and new students.

According to the U.S. Department of Education, "Parents who play an active role in their children's education make a huge difference in their success." Here are some ways you can help your child prepare for the upcoming school year:

- Transition from summer to school routines a few days before school starts
- Ensure your child eats breakfast and lunch (all schools provide breakfast before school and lunch)
- Review start and end times for school
- Arrive on time each day
- Confirm your child knows who will drop off and pick them up daily, or if they will walk home
- Help your child prepare their backpack
- For elementary students: check backpacks daily for important information
- For middle school students: ask daily about school news, homework, and assignments
- Reassure your child that they will do well on the first day

School attendance is crucial. Research shows that students who attend school every day are most likely to succeed academically and in life. In fact, students with excellent attendance read at grade level or higher, are four times more likely to graduate high school, attend college, and develop healthy life habits.

Below are our grade level school start and dismissal times. For school safety reasons please drop off and pick up your child from the front parking lot of the school. Only preschool students should be walked each morning by their parent/guardian to the classroom to sign them in and check them out. Parents/guardians entering a school should sign in at the front office, wear a visitor name badge, and have an appointment if meeting with a staff member. Please refer to our <u>district's visitor policy</u> and <u>civility policy</u> for detailed information about school safety, civility, and the importance of protecting the instructional school day for students.

Reminder: The first week of school (July 28 - August 1) will have a Minimum Day schedule.
